### HEAD COACH PAM ADAMS



Fort Lewis College head softball coach Pam Adams just completed her ninth season as the Skyhawks head coach. This past season the Skyhawks claimed their first ever RMAC Championship and advanced to the NCAA Division II National Tournament for the first time in the program's 25-year history.

Adams, who coached the volleyball program from 1999-2003, was promoted to assistant director of athletics and the senior women's administrator in November 2003.

Adams was hired as the head softball and volleyball coach in 1999. In 2001, Adams was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Coach of the Year for softball, after leading the Skyhawks to a 27-17 record; a vast change from the previous year when the team went 0-40. In her five years with the volleyball program, Adams has the third most wins in the volleyball program with a 38-98 (.388) record. Her 63 wins on the softball diamond are the second most wins ever gained by a Fort Lewis College softball coach.

Prior to arriving at Fort Lewis College, Adams coached softball one year at Southwest Community College in Creston, Iowa. From 1997-98, she was a graduate assistant volleyball coach at Fort Hays State, earning a Master of Science degree in health and human performance with a background in sports administration, sports psychology, and adaptive physical education.

Before receiving her Master's degree, Adams was head coach at Labette Community College in Parsons, Kans. from 1997-97. She spent the previous four years as the assistant and head volleyball and softball coach at Missouri Valley College (1992-96) where she was also a admissions and financial aid counselor. In December of 1990, Adams graduated from Missouri Valley College where she played volleyball and softball and received her undergraduate degree in physical education.

Adams is the fourth head softball coach in the 18-year history of the Skyhawk softball program. Previous Fort Lewis College softball coaches have included Peppy Seale (1984), Hayes (1985-95) and Don Piccoli (1996-99).
